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

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

Ega helped Dani break open his chicky bank. He put his money aside on the bed so it would not get mixed with Dani's money.


Ega lost count of the money so many times. Frustrated, Dani handed him a piece of paper and a pen to jot down his calculations. This way Ega could count the money easier.



Hey, where was his money? The last time he remembered, he had more. Could it be that his money was mixed up with Dani's?

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
Ega quickly called Dani over and told his story while panicking. Dani shook his head while pointing at the chick. Ega grinned, embarrassed.




In fact, Dani was thinking twice about buying a new bag. He thought about his eyes. Maybe he should give his dad his money for new glasses.
