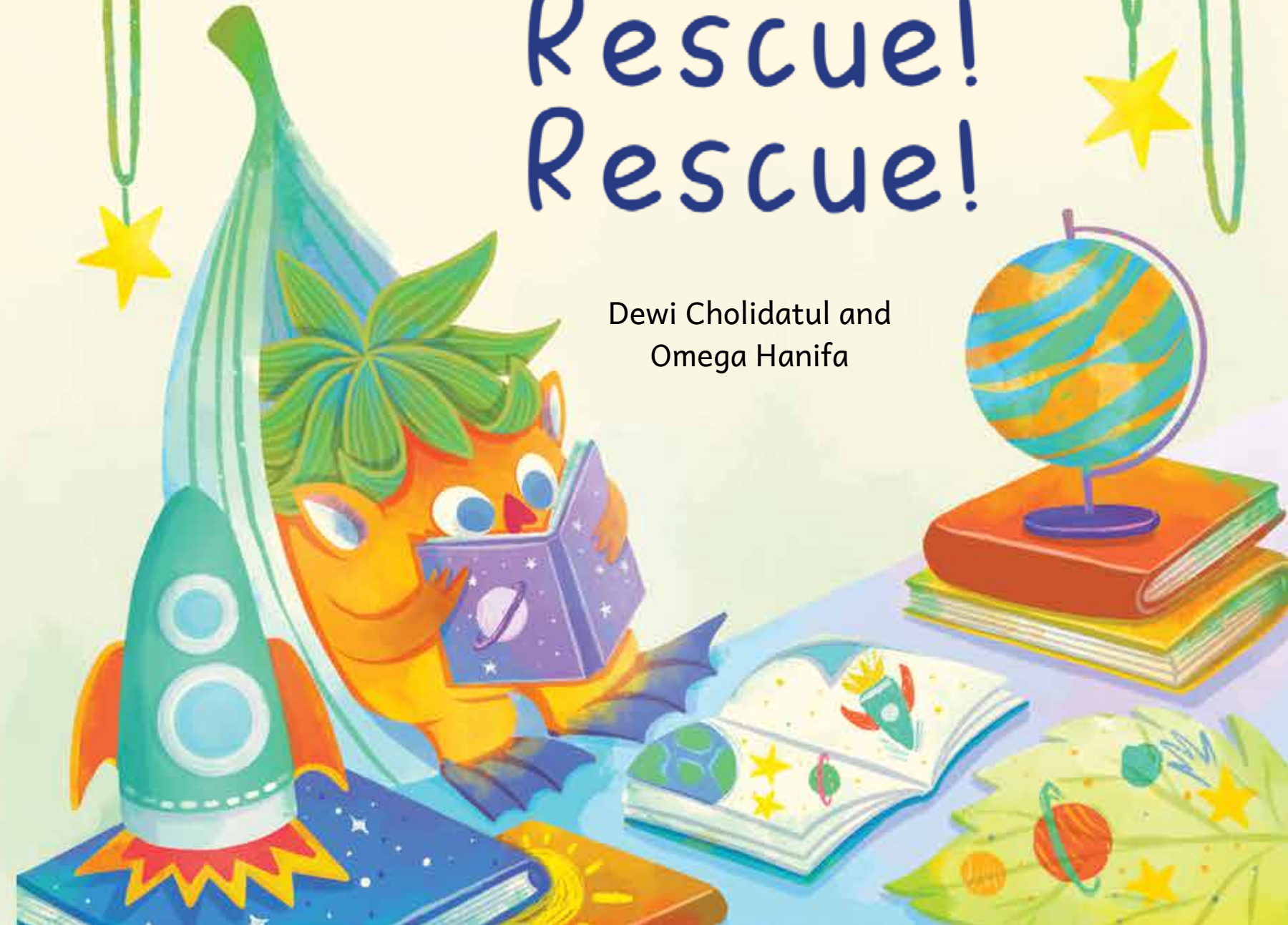

but with one condition...







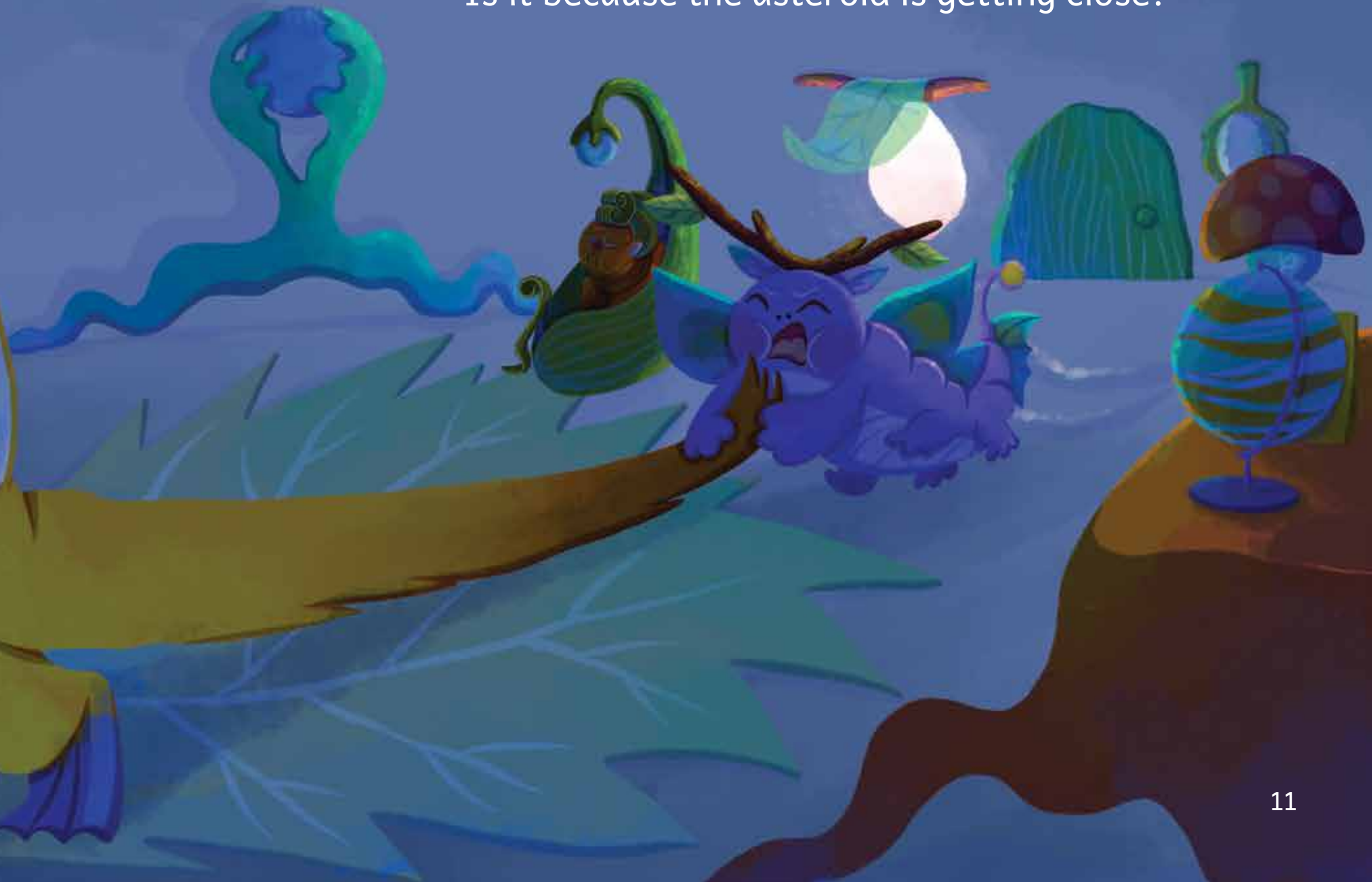
Dun has to play with Bla.

What?



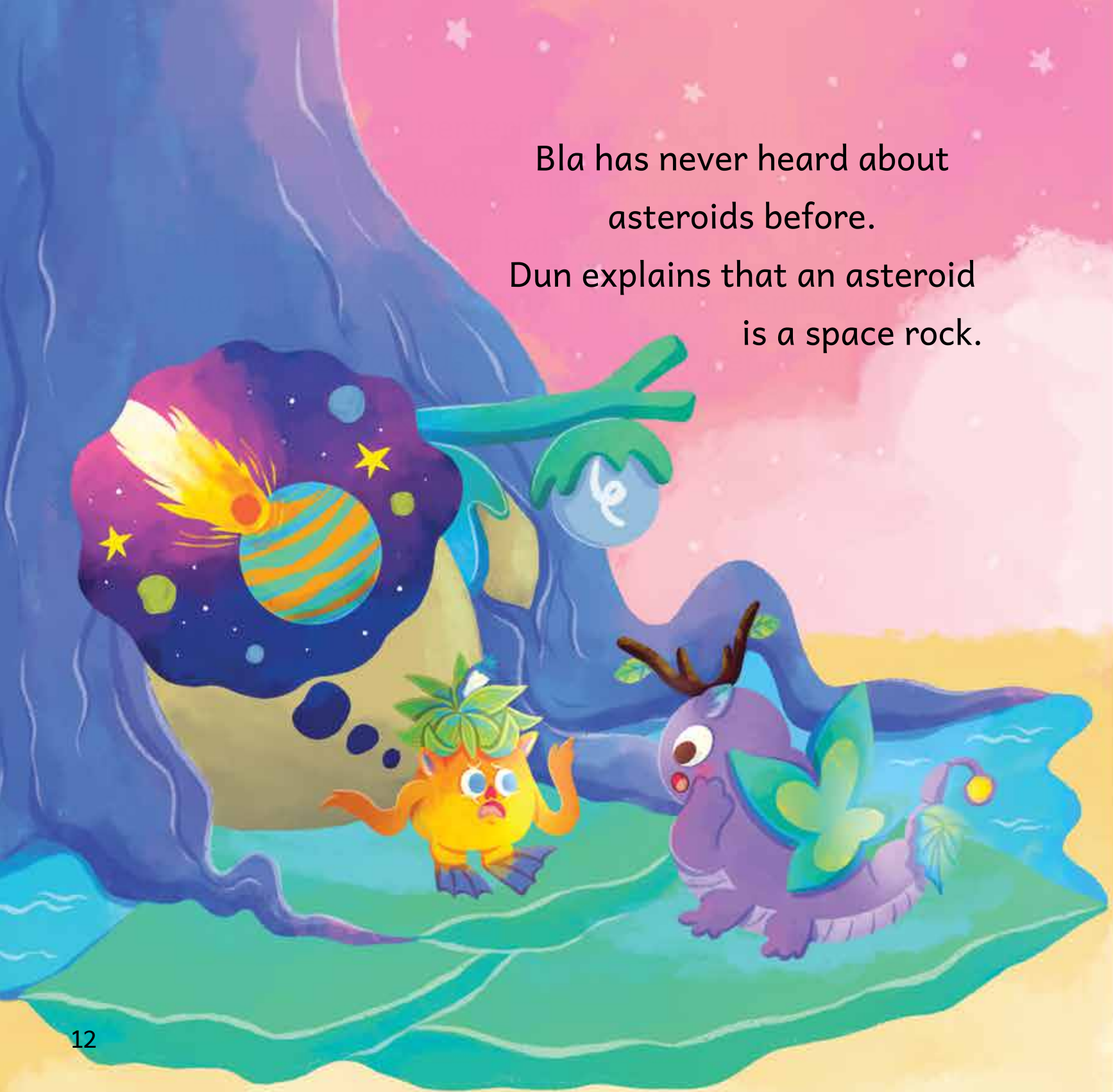
Oh dear, Bla is demanding his attention.

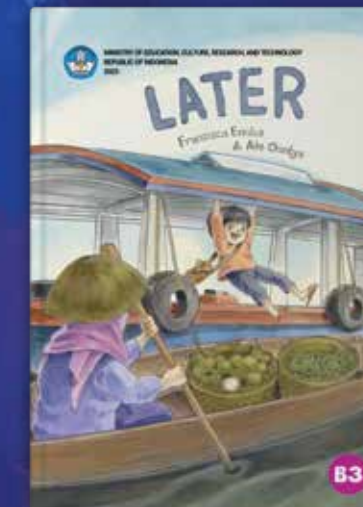
